Final vote on Ordinance No. 3079


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE AND PLACE FOR SALE THE 1,528 SQUARE FOOT HOUSE SITUATED AT 624 W. ORICE ROTH AS THE CITY DOES NOT NEED THE IMPROVEMENTS TO SERVE A PUBLIC PURPOSE. THE ACT OF SALE SHALL REQUIRE THE BUYER TO REMOVE THE HOUSE FROM THE CITY OWNED PROPERTY AT TEE JOE PARK. THE OFFERING OF THE HOUSE FOR SALE SHALL BE ADVERTISED AT LEAST THREE TIMES IN THE OFFICIAL JOURNAL WITHIN A FIFTEEN DAY PERIOD. THE MAYOR IS FURTHER AUTHORIZED TO ADVERTISE THROUGH ANY OTHER MEDIUM HE DEEMS NECESSARY TO ADEQUATELY PROMOTE THE SALE OF THIS PROPERTY. A BID DATE SHALL BE SET WITH A MINIMUM BID PRICE OF \$35,000.00, WITH THE CONDITION THAT THE HOUSE SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE PROPERTY WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE COMPLETION OF THE ACT OF SALE.


